Sometimes, noun phrases can appear as appositive phrases, a phrase placed after a noun to provide additional information. Here is another example of a much shorter appositive noun phrase: . Julie, my older sister, came to visit me the other day.; In the sentence above, both “Julie” and “my older sister” are nouns that could equally stand as the subject of the sentence.

## Identifying Phrases: Definition, Examples, & Exercises ...

A non-essential clause often starts with a relative pronoun (which, who, whose, or where), but it doesn't in a phrase known as an appositive. An appositive functions like a non-essential clause, but it doesn't have a verb. Here is an example: My doctor, a very unfriendly man, spoke to me for less than a minute.

After an introductory phrase made up of “to” plus a verb and any modifiers (“infinitive”) that tells why. Example: Use a comma even after a short “to” + verb phrase that answers why. 3. Indirect Object. Noun clauses can also act as indirect objects of the verb in the independent clause.. For example: She chose to photograph whomever was willing to pose for her.; In the sentence above, the direct object of the verb chose is the infinitive phrase to photograph. Just like a noun clause, this infinitive phrase is acting like the noun direct object.
