Sometimes, you may be citing sources that share the same ideas or argue for the same viewpoint. In these cases, you may want to cite multiple works in a single in-text citation. Remember, while this is possible, readers may find long strings of citations confusing. Only include citations needed to support your immediate point.

The MLA format is generally simpler than other referencing styles as it was developed to emphasize brevity and clarity. The style uses a straightforward two-part documentation system for citing sources: parenthetical citations in the author-page format that are keyed to an alphabetically ordered works cited page.

What is a works cited page? The works cited page is a list of all the sources cited within the body and notes of your paper. A works cited page should begin on its own page after the end of the paper content and should list all the entries in alphabetical order by the first item in each entry (usually the author's name).

MLA Works Cited: Develop an MLA Works Cited Page!

If you cite the same source repeatedly within a paragraph, you can include the full citation the first time you cite it, then just the page number for subsequent citations. MLA is the second most popular citation style (Smith and Morrison 17-19). It is more popular than Chicago style, but less popular than APA (21).

If the title mentioned is usually indicated by italics, use italics for the title within the title. Examples of these titles are films, novels, entire books, journals, and entire websites.
