Background. not a conscious movement; exponents of the form were a disconnected group of playwrights; the term theatre of the absurd was first coined by scholar Martin Esslin in his 1961 text The Theatre of the Absurd; true absurdist playwrights are few in number: Samuel Beckett, Eugene Ionesco and Jean Genet (with some scholars including Arthur Adamov).
