All scales will sound in octaves in an orchestra setting. Violin and Viola parts are in first position. Cellos will have forward and backward extensions and an occasional shift. The bass parts are necessarily the hardest since the span of an octave in some keys goes beyond first position.

Arpeggios are chords played one note at a time, instead of simultaneously. You can think of them as three- to four-note scales made up of chord tones (the tones used to make up any given chord). These types of note collections allow players to imply the chord changes, even when playing alone.

The 3rd decides whether the scale is major or minor. Scales with a 3rd (or major 3rd) are major, while scales with a b3rd (or minor 3rd) are minor. The 7th creates a pull back to the root note and can be used to create tension. For the most part, scales with a major 3rd have a major 7th and scales with a minor 3rd have a minor 7th (b7th).
